

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

This offer of admission is made to you on condition that:

- a) You have complied with all instructions for acceptance of the University's offer of admission. If you do not accept this offer by the deadline and/or fail to register for your course of study, this offer of admission will be considered withdrawn.
- b) The University is satisfied with the results of your Pre-Admission Medical Examination and that you are free from any disease or illness. You shall undergo further health examinations or tests if required by the University.
- c) The information you have given in your application form is accurate, and you have not withheld material information from the University. Any candidate found to have given inaccurate or false information or to have deliberately omitted material information at the time of application for admission will be refused admission to the University or, in the case of those already admitted, be required to leave or be expelled from the University.
- d) Request for deferment will not be entertained. If you are not able to commence your studies, you will need to apply for the next intake and be considered as a fresh applicant.
- e) You accept and agree to comply with all University statutes, regulations, rules and policies currently in effect and as may be revised from time to time. You agree to sign the Acceptance Record required of all students of the University. Details of this Acceptance Record can be found [here](#).
- f) If you are not a Singapore Citizen or Permanent Resident, you must submit documentary evidence of permission (e.g.: work permit or employment pass) from the relevant authority, to assure the University that you can attend the BTech/BIT course in Singapore legally.
- g) You accept and agree to pay unsubsidised tuition fees for the BTech/BIT Programme if you have previously received a government subsidy/ sponsorship for a completed first degree or higher qualification; these include degrees from NUS/NTU/SMU/SUTD/SUSS/SIT/NAFA and LASALLE College of the Arts, or from an overseas university funded by government scholarship/bursary.
- h) **[For BIT Students]** You are at least 21 years old; **and** meet one of the work experience requirements below:
 - i. Possess two years of full-time work experience; or
 - ii. Have fully discharged your National Service liability with at least one year of full-time work experience; or
 - iii. Are currently employed on a full-time basis with at least one year of full-time work experience.

[For BTech Engineering Students] You are at least 21 years old; **and** meet one of the work experience requirements below:

 - i. Possess two years of full-time work experience; or
 - ii. Have fully discharged your National Service liability; or
 - iii. Are currently employed on a full-time basis.

Note: Part-time employment will not be considered as full-time work experience. A part-time employee is one who works for less than 35 hours a week, under contract of service with an employer.
- i) You are expected to have read and understood the fees payable and degree requirements.
