

The following FAQs are applicable for those pursuing part-time BTech Degree Programmes.

## **NUS Student Financial Aid**

### **Am I eligible for NUS Student Financial Aid to pursue my study?**

Part-time needy undergraduate students who are Singapore Citizens may apply for NUS Financial Aid, which is administered by the NUS Office of Financial Aid (within the Office of Admissions). Needy students will be offered a Financial Aid Package if they are found eligible. The Financial Aid Package that is offered may comprise a combination of the Tuition Fee Loan, NUS Study Loan (tuition fee portion only) and MOE Bursary, depending on the extent of the student's level of need which is assessed based on the declared family income and mitigating factors, if any.

### **Can I apply to deduct my fees from my CPF?**

CPF cannot be used to pay the fees for part-time studies.

### **Can I use my Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA) to pay for my fees?**

Yes, you can. You will need to submit an application for PSEA Funds using Ad Hoc Withdrawal Form. ### **Am I eligible for funding under the skills development fund (SDF)?**

SDF funds are not available for courses above the Diploma level.

### **Is sponsorship available to student?**

There is no sponsorship provided to part-time students. You may, however, approach your company for sponsorship, which is to sponsor you for your course.
