## INTRODUCING APPROACHES TO "BUILDING WITH NATURE"





## **Synopsis**


Climate change, land degradation and marine pollution is accelerating the threat of species extinction and biodiversity loss. This will result in huge disruptions and risks to businesses as the global economy heavily relies on natural capital and ecosystem services. According to the World Economic Forum in 2020, approximately 50% of the global gross domestic product (GDP), or approximately US\$43 trillion, is dependent on nature.

To address this crisis and ensure continued growth, it is important for businesses to actively engage in nature-based solutions. The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) defines nature-based solutions as "actions to protect, sustainably manage, and restore natural or modified ecosystems, that address societal challenges effectively and adaptively, simultaneously providing human well-being and biodiversity benefits".

In this seminar, Dinda Mazeda will share examples of nature-based solutions implemented around the world by the Ecoshape consortium. These pilot projects are part of the "Building with Nature" programme which harnesses the forces of nature to guide the design and construction of water-related infrastructure.
