GENERAL INFORMATION

Who can apply to this scheme?

Singapore Citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents aged 25 years old and above in the year of matriculation, who do not have a Bachelor's degree, and who have a minimum of 4 years full-time working experience (excluding National Service) are eligible for Advance@NUS.

What programmes can I apply to?

NUS will be offering a limited number of programmes for admission in Academic Year (AY) 2020/2021, and may expand in the future.

BEFORE APPLYING

When can I apply?

Applications for Semester 1, Academic Year 2020/2021 (which starts in August 2020) are being accepted from 2nd to 31st March 2020.

How many full-time undergraduate degree programmes can I apply to under the Advance@NUS?

You may only apply to ONE full-time undergraduate degree programme.

How much is the application fee?

The application fee is S\$50 (excluding GST).

If I already have a Bachelor's degree, can I apply?

No. Only those who do not have a Bachelor's degree can apply.

I have more than 4 years of full-time working experience but I am not currently employed – can I apply?

Yes! As long as you meet our eligibility requirements (see General Information above), we welcome your application!

Is National Service (NS) considered as part of my full-time working experience?

No. NS is not considered as part of your full-time working experience.

What is the minimum GPA that will be considered for admission?

There is no minimum GPA considered for admission. Each application is reviewed holistically.

Can I study on a part-time basis?

No, this is a full-time undergraduate program.

WHEN APPLYING

I have forgotten the password I created for my account in the Advance@NUS Application Portal. What should I do?

Click on the “FORGOT PASSWORD” option to reset your password.

What documents do I need to prepare for my application?

Depending on your residency status, please refer to the list on <https://scale.nus.edu.sg/programmes/undergraduate-programmes/AdvanceNUS> (under HOW TO APPLY).

How many referees do I need to submit?

You will need to provide the details of 2 referees. One of your referees has to be a supervisor from your current or previous employment. The second referee can be a supervisor or a co-worker. Choose someone who knows your professional responsibilities and accomplishments. Do note that you are

required to provide your referee's **company email address** as a form of verification. Personal email addresses will not be accepted.

My supervisor is willing to be my referee, what does he or she need to do?

Once you have successfully submitted and paid the application fee, your referee will receive an email notification from NUS requesting a referee report. A link to the form will be provided in the email. This link is unique to your application and will expire in 10 days. It is your responsibility to ensure that your referees complete and submit the online referee report within 10 days from the time an email notification is sent to the referee.

How will I know if my referee has submitted the online referee report for my application?

You will receive an email notification once the referee submits the report.

Do I need to undergo an interview to be considered for admission?

Shortlisted applicants may be invited to interview to assess their suitability for admission. An online interview (i.e. video conference) will be conducted for applicants who do not reside in Singapore.

Can I submit my application without uploading all of my documents?

To ensure a smooth application processing, you are strongly advised to upload all documents for any information declared during your application. Failure to do so will render your application incomplete, which will adversely affect the outcome of your application.

How do I make changes to details in my application?

Prior to submitting your application, you may continue to make changes to your application as you like, except for changing your referees. After you pay the application fee and submit your application, please email your changes to ApplytoAdvance@nus.edu.sg. Depending on the date of request to make changes, it may not be possible to take changes into account.

AFTER APPLYING

I have made payment for my application, will I receive any acknowledgement email?

Yes, an email will be sent to you to acknowledge receipt of your application fee. If you did not receive an email notification, please check your junk and spam folders. Please add our email address (ApplytoAdvance@nus.edu.sg) to your safe senders list to prevent our emails from being blocked or filtered into the junk/spam folder.

What should I do after submitting the online application?

You are strongly advised to check your email regularly for updates regarding your application, as we will correspond with you primarily through email on matters pertaining to document request and interview/entrance test notifications.

How do I check for the outcome of my application?

We will send you an email to let you know when we have reached a decision. You will be able to check the outcome via the Advance@NUS Application Portal by entering your Application Number and Password.

Can I appeal if my application is rejected?

You may appeal if you have obtained new educational qualifications or new employment information to further substantiate your suitability for the programme.
